Chaplain Major General Paul K. Hurley Chief of Chaplains, United States Army

Chaplain (Major General) Paul K. Hurley became the United States Army's 24th Chief of Chaplains on May 22, 2015. He leads the Army Chaplain Corps in providing religious support to the Soldiers and Families of the United States Army.

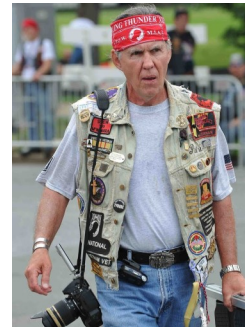
Chaplain Hurley is a 1984 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point. While completing two assignments as a field artillery officer in Germany and at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, he began to discern a call to the priesthood. He resigned his commission in 1990, in order to attend St. John's Seminary in Boston.

Chaplain Hurley was ordained a Roman Catholic priest in 1995, and spent five years as a parish priest in the Archdiocese of Boston, before rejoining the active duty Army as a chaplain in 2000.

Chaplain Hurley's assignments as a chaplain include: Battalion Chaplain, 1st Battalion, 321st Field Artillery Regiment, and later Brigade Chaplain, 18th Field Artillery Brigade, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Brigade Chaplain, 2d Aviation Brigade, 2d Infantry Division, Eighth United States Army, Republic of Korea; Regimental Chaplain, Staff and Faculty, United States Military Academy; Religious Support Chaplain, Multi-National Corps - Iraq; Deputy Command Chaplain, United States Army Special Forces Command (Airborne), and Support Operations Chaplain, United States Army Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Command Chaplain, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), Fort Campbell, Kentucky, including duty as the Combined Joint Task Force 101 Command Chaplain in Regional Command-East, Afghanistan; and Command Chaplain, XVIII Airborne Corps, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, including duty as the Command Chaplain, United States Forces-Afghanistan.
